

Dear voters,

Many of you have called and emailed me about the information you have seen in numerous ads and mailers. I appreciate that each one of you immediately assumed there was something concerning in that bill which I did not support.

It is true that I voted against HJR1048. It is not true that I oppose voter ID. I voted against it BECAUSE I support election security.

The bill, HJR1048, attempted to add to the Oklahoma Constitution a provision permitting tribal cards as valid ID for voting in State and Federal elections. The State of Oklahoma has no jurisdiction over who is issued those cards. Any Oklahoma tribal member should also have a valid state ID. I voted against it. The bill never made it to the governor's desk so it failed.

These IDs are currently accepted in practice. I oppose this practice. And I oppose adding it to the State Constitution.

HJR1048 language: "who upon providing valid identification issued by the United States, the State of Oklahoma, or the government of a federally recognized Indian tribe or nation"
